You and your students are cordially invited to participate in the double-entry non-qualifying speech tournament hosted by Punahou School.

- WHAT:** Non-Qualifying Double-Entry Speech Tournament
- WHERE:** **Punahou School**
1601 Punahou Street, Honolulu, Hawai`i 96822
- WHEN:** Saturday, November 19, 2011
- ENTRY DEADLINE:** Wednesday, November 2, 2011
- PARTICIPATION:** Open to all HSL member schools that have paid their HSL membership dues and submitted their signed membership form.

SPEECH EVENTS:

1. STORYTELLING (ST): No manuscripts may be used. Presentations must be prefaced by an introduction that includes the title and the author of their selection. Selections must be from published or printed sources. Students are encouraged to use the floor space. **MAXIMUM TIME:** 8 minutes.
2. PROGRAM READING (PR): Manuscripts must be used. Presentations must be prefaced by an introduction that includes the titles and authors of each selection. **MAXIMUM TIME:** 10 minutes.
3. HUMOROUS (HI), DRAMATIC (DI) and DUO INTERPRETATION (DUO): Manuscripts can be used until January 1st. Presentations must be prefaced by an introduction that includes the title and author of the selection. Selections must be from published sources (on-line publications are NOT allowed). **MAXIMUM TIME:** 10 minutes.
4. ORIGINAL ORATORY (OO): Manuscripts can be used until January 1st. Manuscripts must be the original work of the student and a copy of it must be available for verification at the tournament. Not more than 150 words of the oration may be direct quotations from any other source. **MAXIMUM TIME:** 10 minutes.
5. IMPROMPTU (IS): Topics shall include quotations, sayings, one-word items, personalities in the news, song titles, etc. No notes permitted during the delivery of the speech. **PREPARATION TIME:** 5 minutes. **MAXIMUM TIME:** 5 minutes.
6. U.S. EXTEMPORANEOUS SPEAKING (USX): Topics will cover US foreign policy and US domestic issues. One note card with less than 50 words may be used prior to January 1st. **PREPARATION TIME:** 30 minutes. **MAXIMUM TIME:** 7 minutes.
7. INTERNATIONAL EXTEMPORANEOUS SPEAKING (IX): Topics will cover foreign policies and actions of many countries including the United States. One note card with less than 50 words may be used prior to January 1st. **PREPARATION TIME:** 30 minutes. **MAXIMUM TIME:** 7 minutes.

REGISTRATION:

All registration must be processed using our official League website www.hawaiispeechleague.org. If you do not have a username or password, please contact Carol Halbur <chalbur@punahou.edu> immediately. The Double Entry form must be completed and either mailed, emailed as an attachment or faxed 943-3639 to Carol Halbur to be received by Wednesday, November 2, 2011.

LIMITS: Each school may register a maximum of thirty-six (36) entries (with each Duo Interpretation team counting as one entry) in any combination of events listed above. Double entry will be permitted **providing they are not two draw categories.**

FEES: \$4.00 per participant. **As a reminder, Duo Interp entries must be paid according to number of participants, not number of entries. Also, competitors who are double-entered must be paid as a single participant in two events (e.g., \$8.00).**

PAYMENT: Payment is due before participation in the tournament.

JUDGES: Each school must provide one (1) adult judge per three (3) speech entries. We will be grateful for any additional judges you can provide. Please inform your judges to be at Punahou School for the orientation at 7:30 a.m. on Saturday. Please direct all changes to your judge's panel and questions regarding judges to Bill Teter at <teter@hawaii.edu> or call 956-4925.

TIMERS: The league requires that all participating schools provide at least one timekeeper for every tournament. We will be grateful for any additional timekeepers that you can provide. Orientation for timekeepers will start at 7:45 a.m. on Saturday.

AWARDS: Certificates will be presented to participants in speech events who earn three or more superiors. Two team trophies will be awarded in speech events: one for the school with the most superiors and the other for highest percentage of superiors. The minimum number of entries to qualify for the overall team trophies is seven (7).

As a reminder, all means will be used to reschedule the drops/no-shows prior to the start of the tournament. However, if rescheduling means extensive delay of the tournament, the first round will commence with the no-shows included.

DIRECTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE DOUBLE ENTRY FORM.

List EVERY student who plans to participate in the Punahou Double-Entry Speech Non-Qualifying Tournament. *Reminders:*

- Please list participants (first and last names) in the following category order: Storytelling, Program Reading, Humorous, Dramatic, Duo, Original Oratory, Impromptu Speaking, United States Extemporaneous, International Extemporaneous, Duet Acting, and Original Poetry. Maximum of 36 entries.
- A student may participate in a maximum two (2) categories, **providing that they are not in two draw categories (IS/USX/IX).**
- Write a double entered student's name on two separate lines, once in each category.
- Put BOTH members of a Duo team on a **single line** in the DUO section on a single line.

AN EXAMPLE OF HOW TO COMPLETE THE DOUBLE ENTRY FORM
