



ACTION TAKEN

The HSL Executive Board adjudicated this protest. Carl Sturges, District II Representative, recused himself from deliberation due to a conflict of interest. LeaDan Yee and Bill Teter were not present during the deliberation. Team 15V11 requested the original source for the definition of the word "substantial" provided by 8V6 during the round. Team 8V6 handed 15V11 a card from a brief book with the counterdefinition they offered. Team 15V11 is claiming that by providing them with only the snippet of the brief book, and not the entire page of the brief book on which the definition was written, Team 8V6 violated Section 7.2.C ["Clipping Evidence"] of the National Speech and Debate Association's Evidence Rules for Policy, Public Forum, and Lincoln-Douglas Debate. The Executive Board recognized that (a) original sources include "copies of electronic versions of published handbooks (i.e., Baylor Briefs; Planet Debate, etc.) [Section 7.1.F.c] and that (b) 8V6 did not have an obligation to provide the entire page of the brief book from which the definition was taken. Therefore, the Executive Board determined that 8V6 did not violate the "Clipping Evidence" rule by providing a snippet from their brief book.

The Executive Board recommends that whenever teams provide their opponents with a cutting from briefs, they should somehow make it clear that the preceding and subsequent evidence is discrete and independent from the evidence requested.





The HSL Executive Board adjudicated this protest. Carl Sturges, District II Representative, recused himself from deliberation due to a conflict of interest. LeaDan Yee and Bill Teter were not present during the deliberation. Team 15V10 claimed they asked for all evidence of 8V5's single disadvantage. Team 8V5, in contrast, claimed their opponents asked for their disadvantage and provided them with their written analysis with the quoted evidence embedded within it. A judge of the round was consulted and unable to verify what was requested by Team 15V10, as it relates to the disadvantage, during the round. When asked after the round, Team 8V5 was able to produce all original sources in the written disadvantage. Because claims about what was asked for in the round are disputed by both sides, and Team 8V5 was able to provide the Executive Board with the evidence of the disadvantage immediately on request, the Executive Board determined that 8V5 did not violate Section 7.1.F.1 [Availability of Evidence] of the National Speech and Debate Association's Evidence Rules for Policy, Public Forum, and Lincoln-Douglas Debate. No action was therefore taken.





REASON FOR PROTEST (Write in detail reason for filing this protest)

Our team asked for the original evidence for something in their cost and funding. The other team handed their cost and funding, when asked for the original evidence, which was one sentence cut and pasted on a MS Word document. When asked for the original evidence, the opponents asked why and claimed that they were quoting from the original source. The opponents also told the judges that they are asking for the original evidence because they want context, and because a counterevidence has not been offered, they do not need to provide the whole article.

Violation: F1. "Any material that is presented during the round must be made available to the opponent during the round if requested. When requested, the original source pages of evidence read in the round must be available to the opponent in a timely fashion during the round."

ACTION TAKEN

The HSL Executive Board adjudicated this protest. Carl Sturges, District II Representative, recused himself from deliberation due to a conflict of interest. LeaDan Yee and Bill Teter were not present during the deliberation. Team 8V4 confirmed, during an interview, they cited evidence from the World Bank Group in their Cost and Funding, but they could not to produce the original source when it was requested by their opponents during the round. Team 8V4 was later able to access and produce through the Internet the World Bank Group original source after the round. Executive Board members were able to determine the evidence was not altered or fabricated. The inability to produce the original source of the evidence, however, when it was requested by their opponent during the debate round is a violation of the "Nonexistent Evidence" rule. Nonexistence evidence occurs when "the debater citing the evidence is unable to provide the original source or copy of the relevant pages when requested by their (*sic*) opponent, judge, or tournament official" [Evidence Rules, Section 7.2.B.1, p. 28, NSDA High School Event Rules Manual] and "the evidence is paraphrased but lacks an original source to verify the accuracy of the paraphrasing" [Evidence Rules, Section 7.2.B.3, p. 28]. The penalty for debaters who violate the nonexistent evidence provision but who are later able to provide the evidence after the round is an automatic loss for the round under protest [Evidence Rules, Section 7.4.C, p. 30]. Because NSDA rules do not address the number of speaker points to award for the losing team, the Executive Board followed what it has done in previous similar protests where nonexistent evidence violations were sustained and awarded 8V4 the lowest possible points (i.e., 16 points) for each ballot.
